Here at BAM we've been listening to our Student Organisations and we are now pleased to offer Sage Pay integration as a new option for your e-commerce provision.

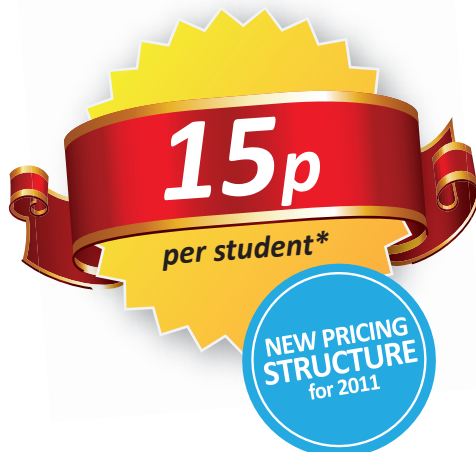
The Sage Pay bolt-on allows your student organisation to receive payment directly to your own nominated merchant bank account. You can also choose whether to charge a nominal booking fee to your purchasers.

Sage Pay is the organisation of Protix, the fastest growing payment service provider (PSP) and Sage, one of the UK's most trusted business brands. Sage Pay offers 25,000+ customers a secure payment service for the millions of transactions that they undertake on the customer's behalf each year.

All transaction information passed between merchant sites and Sage Pay's systems is encrypted using 128-bit SSL certificates. No cardholder information is ever passed unencrypted and any messages sent to your servers from Sage Pay are signed using MD5 hashing to prevent tampering. You can be assured that nothing you pass to Sage Pay's servers can be examined, used or modified by any third parties attempting to gain access to sensitive information.

The e-commerce gateway is compatible with all of the BAM modules that allow payment through your website. The system is also compatible with 'verify by visa' and 'the third man' to reduce any risk of fraud when completing orders on the website platform.

Note: You will need to have an active merchant bank account to use this service, this is available from most high street banks. BAM can help advise you of this service should you require assistance.
